#### CME PORTAL MOBILE APP

Download the free **CloudCME** mobile app from the App Store (Apple) or Google Play (Android) and enter organization code **beaumont**. You must first have an account created in the CME Portal in order to utilize the mobile app.

## ALLOPATHIC (M.D.) CME REQUIREMENTS

### STATE OF MICHIGAN MEDICAL LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

#### M.D.'s: 150 hrs. of CME per 3-year period

#### Category 1 – *minimum 75 hrs.*

- Attendance at or participation in a CME activity approved for *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits\**
- Taking & passing ABMS specialty board certification or recertification exam (max 50 hrs.)
- Successfully completing an activity required for MOC board certification (max 30 hrs.)

#### Category 2 – *max 75 hrs.*

- Clinical instructorship for medical students (max 48 hrs.)
- Presentation of a scientific exhibit, poster, paper (max 24 hrs.)
- Publication of a chapter/portion of a chapter (max 24 hrs.)
- Committee, board, council member (max 18 hrs.)

#### Additional Content-Specific Requirements

- 1 hr. *minimum* medical ethics education
- 3 hrs. *minimum* pain and symptom management education (effective December 20, 2017)
- Training on human trafficking (one-time requirement)

#### OSTEOPATHIC (D.O.) CME REQUIREMENTS

##### AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC ASSOCIATION (AOA) CME REQUIREMENTS

###### 120 hrs. of CME per 3-year AOA cycle

- 30 hrs. **minimum** Category 1A
- 50 hrs. **minimum** Category 1 or 2 in each primary specialty (if board certified) (Refer to your Specialty College for CME requirements)
- 90 hrs. of Category 1A, 1B (attendance and preceptoring\*), 2A, 2B  
\*60 hrs. 1B preceptoring **max credit** each AOA 3-year cycle

##### AOA Credit Categories

###### 1A

**Attendance** at formal, live lecture that is pre-qualified (available for both outside venue or in-house lectures) - requires 50% of speakers to hold D.O. degree

**Speaking** at formal lecture or medical education didactic\*\*

###### 1B

**Attendance** at select committees\*\* (care based/Q.I. focused meetings only)

**Preceptoring** (max 60 hrs. per 3-year cycle)

###### 2A

**Attendance** at formal educational programs approved for *AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™*

###### 2B

Home study courses, journal-type CME on the Internet

#### STATE OF MICHIGAN MEDICAL LICENSE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

##### D.O.'s: 150 hrs. of CME per 3-year period

###### Category 1 – **minimum 60 hrs. (minimum of 40 hrs. must be AOA approved credits)**

- Attendance at a CME activity related to the practice of osteopathic medicine and **approved for AOA credits (min 40 hrs.)**
- Attendance at a CME activity related to the practice of osteopathic medicine and approved for *AMA PRA Category 1 credits* (max 110 hrs.)
- Serving as teacher, lecturer, preceptor, moderator in board approved medical education or training program (max 90 hrs.)
- Member of committee, board, council, or association related to the practice of osteopathic medicine (max 90 hrs.)

###### Category 2 – **maximum 90 hrs.**

- Independently reading peer-reviewed journal (max 90 hrs.)
- Presentation of a scientific exhibit, poster, paper (max 90 hrs.)

###### Additional Content-Specific Requirements

- 3 hrs. **minimum** pain and symptom management education (effective December 20, 2017)
- Training on human trafficking (one-time requirement)
